Conventions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Writer <b>has control</b> of conventions.</li> <li>• <b>Relatively free of errors</b> in spelling, punctuation, sentence structure, and paragraphing.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Writer <b>may have some problems</b> with conventions.</li> <li>• <b>Few errors</b> in spelling, punctuation, sentence structure, and paragraphing.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Writer <b>has some problems</b> with conventions.</li> <li>• Errors do distract the reader, but <b>do not interfere in understanding of the</b> response.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Writer <b>has problems with conventions.</b></li> <li>• <b>errors that interfere in the understanding</b> of the response</li> </ul>
